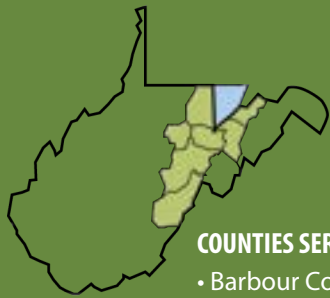

YOUTHBUILD

YouthBuild is an alternative school/work training program. We work with young adults, age 16-24, who need their TASC or work skills to enter the workforce. Most of our students are “At-Risk” youth who have endured a traumatic childhood, students who have not been successful in high school and quit, and young adults who have been referred to our program through the probation/parole system. When they come to our program, it may be the first time in their life that they hear that they can do anything they want in life if they are willing to work for it. I am not exaggerating when I say, that we change lives every single day. These are the students that have slipped through the cracks and have been forgotten. We work with them to earn their High School Equivalency Diploma, teach them valuable work skills on and off the job site, teach resume building, and help them earn certifications that make them more employable. We work with them to get their driver’s permit or license, sign a lease for safe, affordable housing, teach them about self-care, and how to work around the house doing basic household chores like mowing and weedeating.



We spend approximately six to eight months with each crew of students. The first few months we spend team building, gaining their trust, and working to meet their very basic needs in life. For most of our students, it has been too long since they have been to the doctor, the dentist, the eye doctor, the health department, counseling, etc. We take the time to make sure each student gets their basic needs met before entering the workforce because basic needs not being met can hinder them from keeping a job. Such as, missing three days of work for a toothache that should have been fixed years ago, not being able to get their driver’s permit because they need glasses and have no idea how to make an appointment, and even going to the health department for basic care. Some of our students are the only ones in their home that work. They get up every morning and come to work to support their family. We work hard to try and break that generational cycle of system dependency. I have worked for

YouthBuild for a little over four years and I know of approximately 20 students we have successfully broken the generational cycle of welfare dependency. I know 20 is not the biggest number we could have had, but that is 20 adults that are self sufficient. If we can change 20 students every four years, that’s a great feeling.

While enrolled in YouthBuild, our students achieve so much more than just working toward their GED. We build low income housing for the Randolph County Housing Authority, we teach them to interact with their community, jump in and do projects to help make the community a better place to live, and we teach them to take pride in the work they do. We have a very small staff of only five people, but those five people show up every day and work hard to teach these kids that they are worthy, they are smart, they are capable, and they are valued. We have worked with many programs in the four years I have been with YouthBuild and

had the opportunity to do some great projects. A few of our favorite projects have been planting over 1,200 trees in the old town of Spruce, renovating and upgrading facilities at Cass Scenic Railroad, Elkins Make it Shine projects, building the restroom facility at Glendale park, walking dogs at the Humane Society, assisting Elkins Public Library, working to help Beverly open their library, volunteering at Catholic Charities, building Whoville for the library, taking down all the parking meters in downtown Elkins for the city, providing manpower to Homestead School to clean up the facility, assisting the Autism Support Center, unloading the monthly food truck for our local food pantry at Youth Health, building chairs for Davis Medical Center to auction, assisting Harman with flood cleanup, working at 4H weed eating and doing renovations, job shadowing students at the City of Elkins, and countless other projects.



We do more than just volunteer in the community. We have a job shadow program where we partner with local businesses to get our students employed with local business owners. We send our students to local businesses to job shadow and gain valuable work skills. Our students have worked with Davis & Elkins College, Vintage Restaurant, Auto Medic Body Shop, Terra Flora Landscaping, Salon Swish, Creative Beginnings Daycare, Davis Medical Center, Little Rascals Daycare, City of Elkins, Elkins Mainstreet, Dave Davis Heating and Cooling, Elkins Builder's Supply, K&K Collision, The Darden House, S&K Construction, Randolph County Housing Authority, Old Skool Tattoo, Isaac Jackson Hotel, Reliable Roofing, Pack 'N' Ship, El Gran Sabor, Henry G's Café, and Triangle Heating and Cooling, just to name a few. Our students work for these

businesses to gain training in the field and build their resume skills to enter the workforce when they complete our program. When students complete our program, they are expected to further their education or enter the workforce. It is my job at YouthBuild to track each student for one year after they leave the program and make sure they are fulfilling these obligations. If they are not, we assist them in finding employment or applying to school.

In the summer of 2021 we were informed that we did not receive our grant funding through the U.S. Department of Labor. We immediately sprang into action and went into fundraising mode. The Tucker Community Foundation's Run For It event was our top priority to provide the gap funding we needed to operate. We needed

the fundraiser to keep our doors open and continue helping young adults in our area. With the help of the funds raised at the Run For It event, we were able to start a new crew in September of 2021, even though we did not have our YouthBuild grant. The money we raised has assisted in helping ten at-risk youth earn their high school equivalency (TASC), gain work skills needed to enter our local workforce, and earn certifications needed to make them more employable. We are very grateful for the working relationship we have with the Tucker Community Foundation and we will forever be grateful for the funds we received to keep our doors open. In a time where our jobs were in jeopardy, the Foundation was a part of us being able to continue helping our local youth.





UNCLE SAM'S BIRTHDAY PARTY

A long-standing tradition in Canaan Valley, Uncle Sam's Birthday Party is the Foundation's annual elimination dinner held at Canaan Valley Resort.

The event was started by the late Dr. Tom Patrick, former President of Tucker Community Foundation, and a much beloved dentist in Davis. He served as an unforgettable and entertaining emcee for many years. The party is a tribute to his memory and a major fundraiser for the Foundation. Tickets go on sale in May and can be purchased at the Foundation office or from any Foundation board member. A single ticket includes dinner for 2, a chance to win a door prize, and your name entered in the \$5000 drawing. Only 249 tickets are sold. Proceeds from the event support unrestricted grant and scholarship awards for local organizations and students. RUN FOR IT



The event was virtual for 2020 & 2021, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but since its inception, Run For It has generated more than \$2.5 million for participating organizations throughout the region - Barbour, Grant, Mineral, Pocahontas, Preston, Randolph, and Tucker counties, WV and Garrett County, MD.

The Tucker Community Foundation challenged participants to raise team support for the community cause of their choice during the Virtual Run For It 2020 & 2021 campaigns and then run or walk for that cause in a 2k/5k event during the month of September.

The purpose of Run For It was to raise awareness and support for non-profits, civic organizations, and other charities. The program started in 2007 as a means to promote a healthy activity and encourages local philanthropy. Throughout the years it has evolved into a solid challenge-grant program that has been successful beyond all expectations.

Every year, Run For It kicks off on April 1st. The Tucker Community Foundation challenges participants to raise team support for the community cause of their choice during a six-month campaign and then run or walk for that cause in a 2k/5k in September.

Cash awards are given to teams raising the most awareness and support, along with demonstrating the best effort. Additionally, half of entry fees, 100 percent of team sponsor donations, and 100 percent of race awards are distributed to the cause represented.

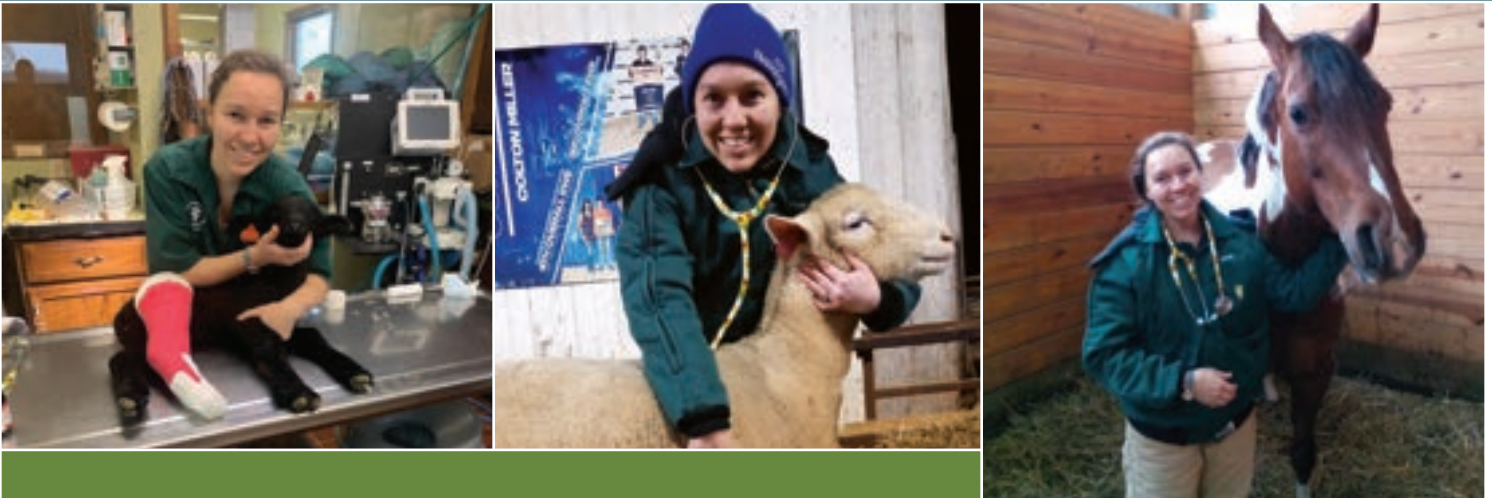

Katelyn Gnegy Roth is the Tucker Community Foundation's first Veterinarian supported by the Joyce Colbert Scholarship.

Katelyn, now Dr. Roth, DVM, grew up in Oakland, Maryland on one of our wonderful local small farms. At a very young age, she developed a love and interest for animals, specifically large animals.

She was determined to become a veterinarian. Throughout her schooling, her dedication to become a veterinarian grew stronger, especially as she worked with her family to develop a successful farming operation in Garrett County. She graduated from Southern High School, and then attended Garrett College earning an Associate Degree in science before entering the University of Maryland where she graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in animal science, respectively.

Following graduation from the University of Maryland, she was accepted into Purdue's College of Veterinary Medicine Class of 2020 and applied to Tucker Community Foundation for funding under the Joyce Colbert Scholarship Fund. "Becoming a veterinarian was my life-long dream," Katelyn told the Tucker Community Foundation Board during her first interview. Veterinary Medicine is probably the most demanding medical field there is, "Every patient is different and since they cannot tell me what is hurting, we have to learn to become part of their lives and special circumstances," Katelyn reminds us, "but every patient is just as special as one of us."

Veterinary science is not only demanding of every doctor's talents, but increasingly expensive to study. The costs of veterinary training are often higher than any other medical field. Veterinarians often graduate with debts exceeding \$200,000. Paying these loans usually demands that they enter practice on companion-animals rather than farm animals because their income potential is much higher.

Katelyn has chosen to contribute as much of her professional talent as possible to the support of the American livestock industry, in keeping with the mandate of the Colbert Scholarship.

"It was with the help the Joyce Colbert Veterinary Scholarship, that I was able to fund my education," Katelyn is proud to say, "and the Colbert Scholarship was essential to that dream." The Scholarship was initiated by the Tucker Community Foundation in honor of Dr. Colbert following her passing at a very young age.

"I also had the privilege of knowing Dr. Colbert. On numerous occasions, my family needed her out to the farm to care for our animals. Dr. Colbert was always very supportive and encouraging of my dream to become a large animal veterinarian, taking time to teach and explain things to me," Katelyn tells us. "I will be forever in her debt."

Upon graduating Purdue, Katelyn took a job in a rural farming town in northeast Indiana. "I work at a mixed animal practice, spending half my time as a large animal veterinarian and half my time as a small animal doctor. "This is a close to heaven as one can come in veterinary practice."

Katelyn continues to help and support future veterinarians through her work as a dedicated and outgoing 4-H and FFA member. "It was always a goal of mine to continue my involvement with the youth of these organizations. My role as a large animal veterinarian has allowed me to work with 4-H and FFA youth to provide care for their animals as well as show them the opportunities as a veterinarian."

"My long-term goal is to operate my own clinic and continue to give back to my community, while sharing my love for veterinary medicine with others. I cannot thank those enough in the Tucker Community Foundation who made my dream of becoming a veterinarian possible."

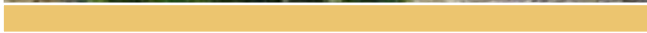
