ENTRY FEES



Event Rules

Failure to follow any of the rules set forth by the Foundation will result in disqualification from Run For It and may affect future participation in the event.

All participants are to operate within the spirit of Run For It and are to function ethically and honestly in relation to the event.

Race Rules

- 2k walk only means just that no running. One foot must always be on the ground.
- Walkers, runners, wheelchairs and strollers are permitted. Other wheeled transport is not allowed.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a short leash and must be picked up after. No other animals, please!
- Dogs cannot register for the race. FIDO is welcome to run or walk but cannot register as a team member.
- Runners with dogs line up at the back of the pack or get disqualified.
- Banners used on site in conjunction with the Run For It event must be pre-approved by Tucker Community Foundation; no exceptions.
- Entries are not transferable. Bib switching will result in disqualification.

Team Rules

- Teams must register by August 31. Minimum of 5 team members on race day to qualify for team awards. Teams should not represent multiple causes.
- All solicitations for team sponsor support must state: Funds are being raised in support of [Team cause] for the Tucker Community Foundation Run For It event. (see Page 12)
- Participants must not provide any goods or services in exchange for a sponsor's contribution.
- Participants may send letters to sponsors detailing the event and requesting donations, but may not use the TCF logo.
- Team sponsor donations must be postmarked by September 11.
- Cash awards must benefit the regions served by TCF. Proceeds from entry fees and team sponsor donations may be used outside the TCF service area as long as it supports the team's cause as it is stated on the team registration form.

TCF reserves the right to review all donations. If a donation does not conform to TCF Asset Development Policies, the Foundation has the right to return the donation. TCF has exclusive legal control over any contributed assets.
